

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To **Sundy Huang**, candidate for Ward 7 Councillor in the City of Markham, and to the City Clerk of Markham

Qualified Opinion

We have audited the accompanying financial statement (Form 4) of **Sundy Huang** (the "Candidate"), candidate for Ward 7 Councillor in the City of Markham, for the campaign period from June 6, 2018 to December 31, 2018, in connection with the municipal election held on October 22, 2018, which comprises of Box C: Statement of Campaign Income and Expenses, Box D: Calculation of Surplus and Deficit, Schedule 1 – Contributions, and Schedule 2 – Fundraising Events and Activities for the campaign period ended December 31, 2018 and summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information. The financial statements have been prepared by the Candidate based on financial reporting provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 and guidance issued by Ministry of Municipal Affairs.

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, these financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, for the campaign period ended December 31, 2018 in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 and guidance issued by Ministry of Municipal Affairs.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of electoral campaigns of this type, the completeness of the various categories of income and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these sources of income and expenses was limited to amounts recorded in the records of the campaign and we were not able to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence over and were consequently not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to various categories of income and expenses, as well as the surplus or deficit, for the campaign period ended December 31, 2018

We conducted our audits in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Candidate and campaign in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Emphasis of Matter – Basis of Accounting

We draw attention to Note 1 to the financial statements, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial statements are prepared to assist the Candidate to meet the requirements of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 and guidance issued by Ministry of Municipal Affairs. As a result, the financial statements may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for the candidate and the city clerk, and should not be used by parties other than the candidate and the city clerk. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of the Candidate for the Financial Statements

The Candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 and guidance issued by Ministry of Municipal Affairs, and for such internal control as the Candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the campaign's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by management.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.
